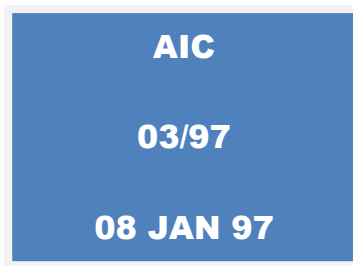

Due to several complaints of the local authorities concerning the violation of prohibited area TNP-2 on the island of Bonaire, pilots are hereby reminded to adhere to the limits as published in the AIP Netherlands Antilles for this area and the following rules and regulations:

1. Aircraft shall not be flown in a prohibited area, or in a restricted area, the particulars of which have been duly published, except in accordance with the conditions of the restrictions or by permission of the state over whose territory the areas are published (annex 2 page 7 para 3.1.10).
2. Before beginning a flight, the pilot in command of an aircraft shall become familiar with all available information appropriate to the intended operation (annex 2 page 6 para 2.3.2).
3. Air Traffic Control Clearances are based solely on the requirements for providing Air Traffic Control Service (annex 11 page 18 para 3.7) and do not give permission to pilots to violate any other rules and regulations established by the appropriate authority.
